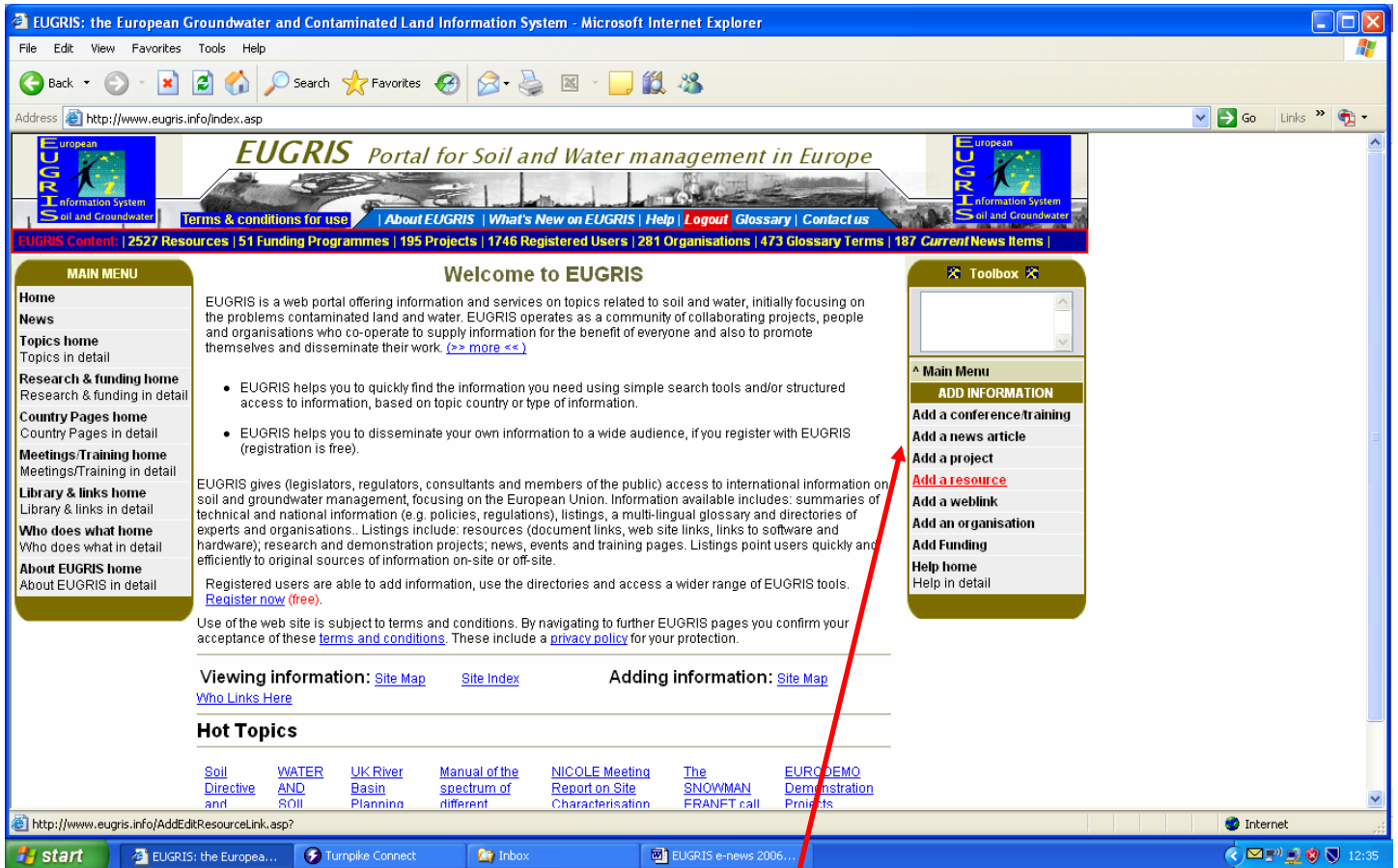

Choose what information you want to add, click and complete the forms. Be careful to say what type of resource / project etc and to carefully select keywords. These are what tell EUGRIS where to show your information.

Make sure that you avoid duplicating an entry (you should receive a warning if this will happen).

Be sure to add a web link (e.g. to your own pages) so people can get more information straight away (e.g. a download). This will make your entry far more attractive and usable.
